WHAT WE DO

The Wings of Hope Medical Relief & Air Transport (MAT) program is a lifeline for families who have no way to access the specialized care they need when medical crises arise. For more than 16 years, the MAT program has been flying patients living within a 600-mile radius of our St. Louis headquarters to advanced health care at world-class hospitals in our 29-state service area. Over that time, Wings of Hope has transported thousands of patients completely free of charge. From their very first flight with us, our patients are part of the Wings of Hope family.

Our care continues with as many flights as needed - at no cost - for as long as needed.

The MAT program is powered by our team of 20 volunteer pilots, and many more mechanics, doctors, nurses and patient flight advocates who volunteer their time because they see the need of people who cannot access specialized medical care – and they want to help. Our volunteers devote countless hours to meeting our strict training requirements – pilots must have a minimum of 1,000 hours flight time. They are passionate about what they do, because they have great compassion for the people we serve.

MAT PROGRAM FACTS

Since July 2018, the MAT program has logged...

- · 2,646 hours dedicated from volunteer pilots
- · 255,261 total miles flown

We are the only free medical air transport service in the United States that owns our own aircraft specially outfitted to accommodate non-ambulatory patients.
